

# Craps

Craps is a game of chance and is played on a large sunken table with a pair of dice that are thrown by the Shooter.

The objective is to bet whether the Shooter will roll a winning combination. On the first roll of the dice (the **come-out phase**), the shooter wins by rolling either a 7 or 11. Rolling **craps** (2, 3, or 12) loses. Any other number (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10) is called the **point** and brings the game into the **point phase**. To win, the point number must be rolled again before a 7 is rolled. Winning here is also known as **passing**. If a 7 is rolled before the point number, the shooter has **sevens-out** and loses.

When the game starts, there are two main bets: Pass and Don't Pass. There are, however, several other side bets that you can take:

Bet Type	Description of Bet
<b>Pass Line</b> bet	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 7 or 11 on the come-out roll, or establish a <b>Point</b> by rolling 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10.
<b>Don't Pass</b> bet	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 2, 3 or 12 on the come-out roll, or establish a <b>Point</b> by rolling 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10.
<b>Come</b> bet	This is a bet similar to the <b>Pass Line</b> bet, but can only be taken after a <b>Point</b> is established. It is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 7 or 11 on the next roll, or make a Point. <b>Note:</b> A <b>Come</b> bet can be made on every roll of the dice only after the Shooter has established a Point.
<b>Don't Come</b> bet	This is a bet similar to the <b>Don't Pass</b> bet, but can only be taken after a Point is established. It is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 2, 3 or 12 on the next roll, or will not make the Point before rolling a 7.
<b>Odds</b> bet	These are additional bets made on an established <b>Pass</b> , <b>Don't Pass</b> , <b>Come</b> or <b>Don't Come</b> bet.
<b>Place to Win</b> bet	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll the number that a <b>Win</b> bet is placed on - 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10, before a 7 is rolled.
<b>Place to Lose</b> bet	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 7, before the number that a <b>Lose</b> bet is placed on - 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10, is rolled.
<b>Field</b> bet	This is a single roll bet that the Shooter will roll a 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 or 12, on the next roll.
<b>Hardways</b> bet	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll either a 2, 3, 4 or 5 as a double, before it is thrown in any other combination, or before a 7 is rolled.
<b>Any Seven</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 7 on the next roll.
<b>Any Craps</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 2, 3 or 12 on the next roll.
<b>Craps Two</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 2 on the next roll.

<b>Craps Twelve</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 12 on the next roll.
<b>Craps Three</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll a 3 on the next roll.
<b>Eleven</b>	This is a bet that the Shooter will roll an 11 on the next roll.
<b>Big 6</b>	This is a bet that a 6 will be rolled before a 7.
<b>Big 8</b>	This is a bet that an 8 will be rolled before a 7.
